When we have confirmed attendees I will purchase tickets and arrange carpool. You are responsible for the cost of your ticket (about \$25) and your passenger ferry fare. New Horizons will reimburse drivers for vehicle ferry fares and mileage allowance, to claim there must be a minimum of three recognized New Horizons members in the vehicle, (this may include the drive). For audit purposes please attach Ferry receipt (or a copy) to the travel claim.
