An experienced playwright going through a dry spell, a talented amateur with a winning script, a supportive but reluctant spouse, a clairvoyant neighbour, and a friendly attorney, meet in a remote home. *Deathtrap* weaves an intricate tale of greed and ambition that will leave you wondering what will happen next. Two-thirds thriller and one-third comedy, this play will leave you guessing and laughing.

Four badass women lose their heads in this irreverent comedy set during the French Revolution's Reign of Terror. Playwright Olympe de Gouges, assassin Charlotte Corday, former Queen Marie Antoinette, and Haitian rebel Marianne Angelle hang out, murder Marat, and try to beat back the extremist insanity in 1793 Paris. This grand and dream-tweaked comedy is about violence and legacy, art and activism, feminism and terrorism, compatriots and chosen sisters, and how we actually go about changing the world.
